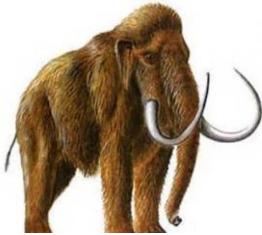


# Home Learning ...
