Exploring these texts will enable us to:

Use vocabulary and forms of speech increasingly influenced by our experiences of books

Read simple words and sentences

Read common irregular words

Demonstrate understanding when talking about what we have read Write simple sentences which can be read by ourselves and others

Expressive Arts and Design

Through taking part in a range of creative based activities we will:

Sing songs, make music and dance and experiment with ways of changing them. Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.

Understanding The World We will explore the world around us and:

Know about similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things. Talk about the features of our immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another. Make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur and talk about changes.

Maths

This term in Numbers we are focusing on:

Count reliably with numbers from 1-20
Place them in order
Say one more or one less than a given number
Add and subtract 2 single digit numbers
Count on or back to find the answer
Solve problems including doubling, halving and sharing

This term in Shape, Space and Measure we are focusing on:

Using every day language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money
Recognise, creating and describing patterns
Talk about the properties of and name 2D and 3D shapes

Physical Development
