We are delighted to inform you that Year 6 have been invited to attend the "Lord Lieutenant's Remembrance Service" at St Mary's Collegiate Church in Warwick to commemorate the end of WW1. This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to take part in this very important historical event. We will leave school by coach at 9.15am and will return later on during the morning. Arrival time back to school is dependent on length of service so we are asking all pupils to bring a packed lunch and drink, which will be left in school and eaten on our return. There is no charge for this trip.

The church will be decorated with thousands of handmade poppies displayed to coincide with the centenary of the end of world war one. There will be many other schools participating and the special guests will include the Lord Lieutenant, High Sheriff, Bishop of Warwick, Mayor of Warwick and leaders of the district and local councils.

We will be learning the hymns that will be sung during the service to ensure all pupils are familiar with them.

Pupils have been asked to bring a small, working torch with them, kindly ensure your child has one that will easily fit in a coat pocket; we will not be taking bags/rucksacks.
