Children - Remember to take pictures and do a small write up for any investigation or project that you complete.

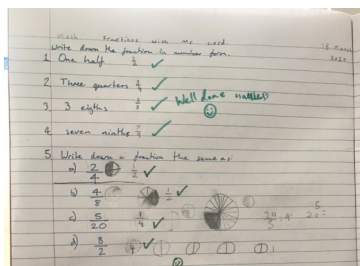
