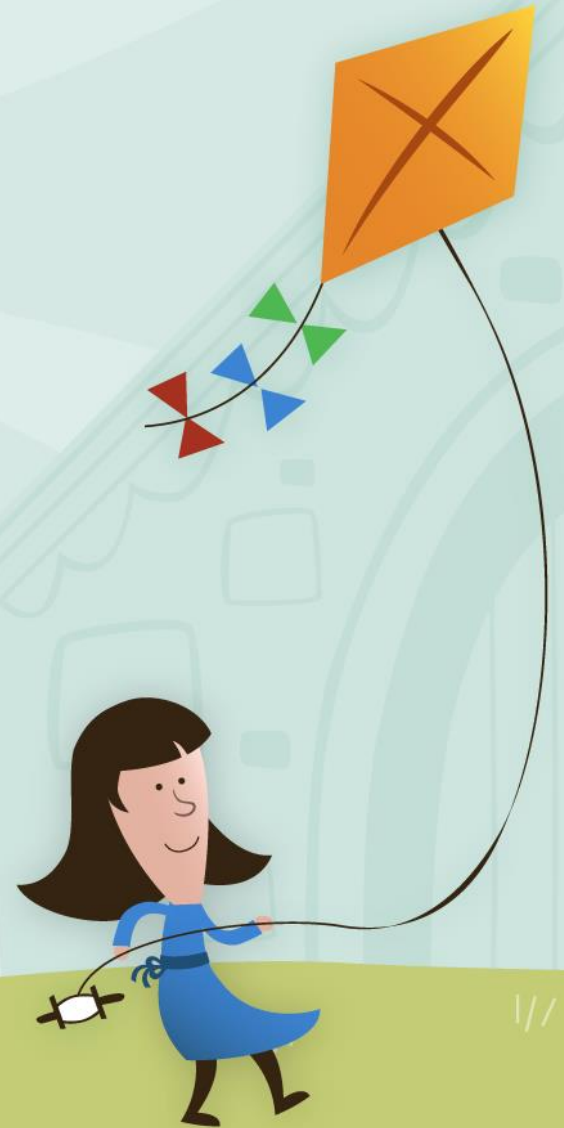

# A typical day in Year 1...

A typical day in Year 1 is fast paced and action packed!

Children arrive at school, put their belongings away and settle down on the carpet quietly to complete their early morning activities during registration time.

Each morning we teach maths, English and phonics.

Lunch – we eat our lunch in the hall then go outside.

In the afternoon we will have a topic lesson followed by time in provision.



# Learning through play in Year 1....

In Year 1 we have a heavy focus on learning through play. This allows the children to develop their independence, resilience, and determination as well as covering all areas of the curriculum.

The classroom is set up with lots of resources that the children can access to facilitate their learning.







Each week the children have independent challenges to complete. These challenges are linked to our topic.

As well as completing the challenges the children will also complete set work with adult support. For example, after a Maths lesson the children will work with an adult to complete an activity linked to the lesson. This is done in groups and one to one.

Spellings and GPS	<b>SPELLINGS FOCUS</b> Spellings taken from The Spelling Shed – 1 Spelling pattern per week Some pupils will have specific spellings taken from their books for an area of focus:							
	Spelling rule: The /f/, /v/, /s/, /z/ and /k/ sounds are usually spelt as ff, vv, ss, zz and ck if they come straight after a single vowel letter in short words.	Spelling rule: The /x/ sound spelled 'x' before e, l and y. The /ck/ sound found at the end of words usually comes after a vowel.	Spelling rule: The -ch This sound is usually spelled as 'ich' when it comes after a single vowel letter.	Spelling rule: Some words end with an /e/ sound spelled 'y'. English words hardly ever end with the letter 'e', so if a word ends with a /e/ sound, the letter 'e' usually needs to be added after the 'y'.	Spelling rule: Adding s and es to words (plural) If the ending sounds like /s/ or /z/, it is spelled as -s. If it forms an extra syllable, then it is spelled as -es.	Spelling rule: Adding the suffixes -ing and -ed to verbs. If the verb ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on. # How we assess the children...

Assessment in KS1 is carried out daily, using live marking as the children are working. This is to ensure that feedback is immediate and children can respond immediately, ensuring the misconceptions are quickly addressed.

Children may then be grouped according to their ability or need.

Throughout the year, children will take part in assessments in reading, writing and mathematics to inform us of next steps; gaps in learning etc.

Children will be assessed in phonics in Year 1 in June. This is a check where the children have to read real and nonsense (alien) words. E.g. wup

It is completed in a relaxed and informal way. Children are **not** made aware that it is a formal assessment and it is completed with Miss White.

# Handwashing is also very much a part of our daily routine!

Hand sanitisers are positioned all around the school for children to access on entering the school; before and after playtimes and before and after eating.

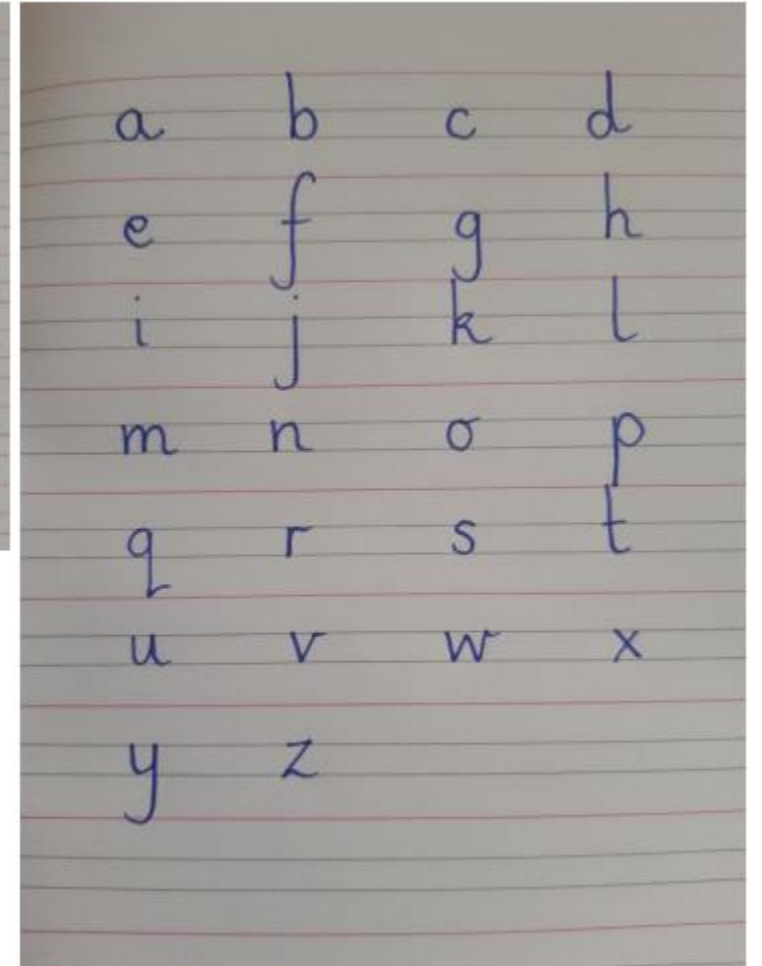
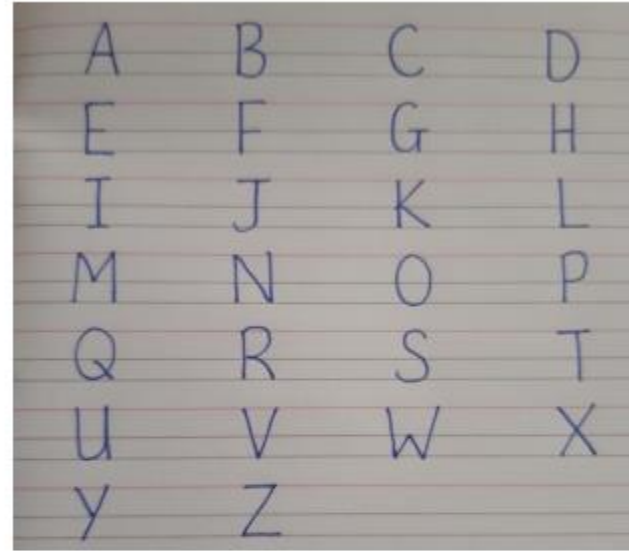
Books are changed as and when they have both been read at home, please ensure you have recorded when you have read with your child as books will only be changed if we can see they have been read at home.

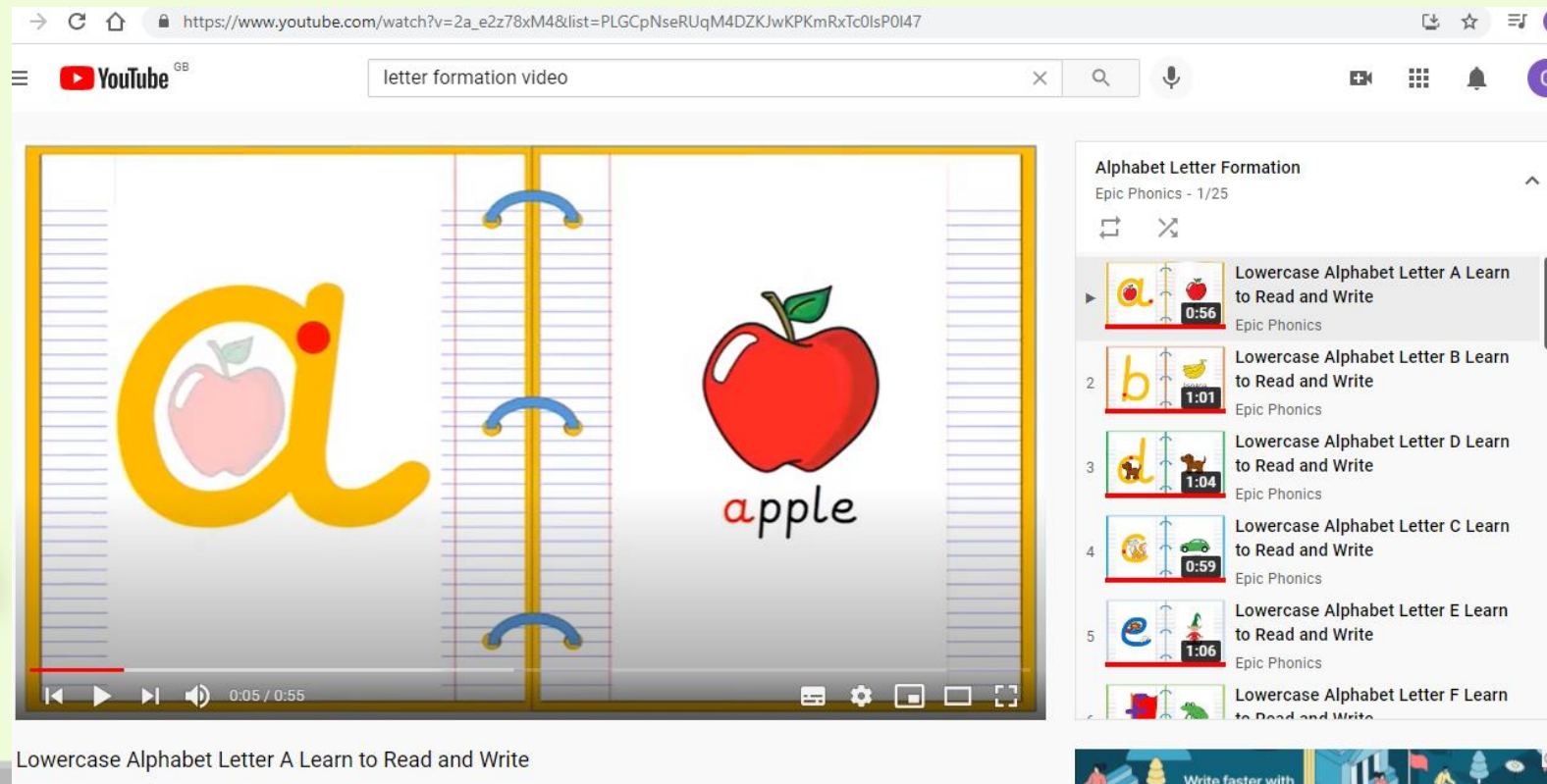
