Your help and support has been invaluable over the last year, thanks to everyone for making 2019 a successful one.

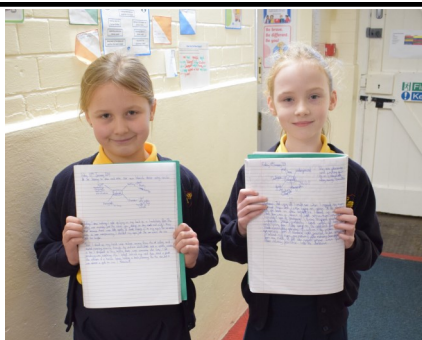
### Lunchtime Circus!
